The Web Archiving Service interface is shown in four stages:

- 1. Create Site:** A form to provide URLs, capture settings, and metadata for sites to be captured.
- 2. Capture Site:** A screen showing the progress of capturing a site, with a 'Recent Capture Activity' table.
- 3. View Captures:** A screen to search, browse, and display archived content, including review capture reports.
- 4. Public Access:** A screen to configure the project for public access, including setting the description, URL, and banner.



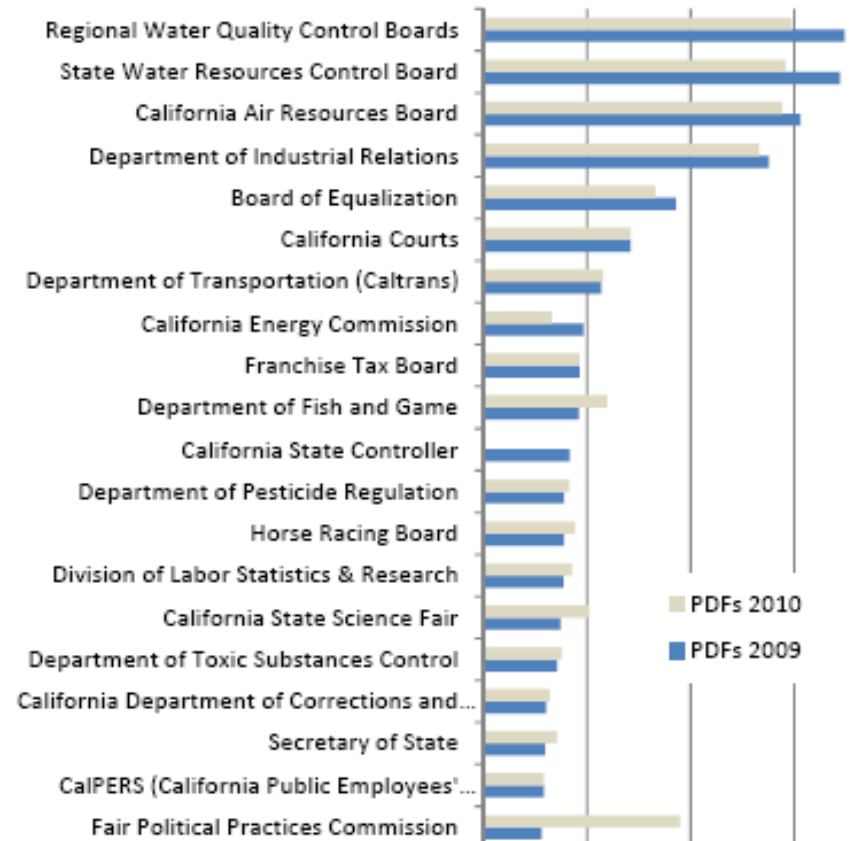
